STEWARDSHIP CORE TEAM GOALS AND OBJECTIVES

MISSION To foster a Stewardship parish where parishioners recognize that all they have is really a gift from God, who asks them to return a portion, in thanksgiving, in the form of their time, talent, and treasure.

GOAL 1 Build a Sense of Community in the Parish

OBJECTIVES:

- Establish Stewardship as the foundation of all parish ministries.
- Have a well-staffed Stewardship Core Team that meets on a regular basis.
- Promote the Stewardship concept at every opportunity – from the pulpit, in the bulletin, after masses, in conversation, at parish events – particularly when the concept coincides with elements of the liturgical year.
- Take responsibility for developing weekly, monthly, and annual Stewardship opportunities. These could include:
 - Weekly Bulletin presence
 - Outreach Sunday
 - Stewardship Sunday (was Ministry Sunday)
 - Parishioner Appreciation Sunday
 - Stewardship Renewal Week and Annual Mailing
- Establish a Stewardship Library.
- Be aware of, and make good use of diocesan Stewardship materials and programs that could benefit the parish.
- Maintain an updated web presence on the OLQA website.

GOAL 2 Annual Plan

OBJECTIVES:

- Core Team and parish personnel cooperate in identifying annual Stewardship events.
- Coordinate with the Diocese, and other parish ministries and personnel to determine an annual event schedule.
- Calendar the schedule, and assign Core Team members and others (as needed) to coordinate events.
- Review and/or revise calendar at monthly Core Team meetings.

GOAL 3 Discernment

OBJECTIVES:

- Encourage personal invitations to ministry, as well as to parish events.
- Educate Parish Leadership by encouraging them to attend “Called & Gifted” workshops (Catherine of Siena Institute).
- Support and/or host “Called and Gifted” workshops (Catherine of Siena Institute).
- Promote “Living Your Strengths – Catholic Edition” (Gallup Press).
