PALM SUNDAY, MARCH 28

HOLY THURSDAY, APRIL 1



Morning Prayer at 8:30a.m.

Mass of the Lord's Supper at 7:30p.m.

Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament following Mass until midnight in the Parish Hall.

Today we celebrate Jesus Christ's institution of the priesthood and the Eucharist which is the source and the summit of Christian life. During this Mass the pastor, Fr. Kerry Beaulieu, will wash the feet of twelve parishioners as Christ did for his twelve disciples. We remember that the Eucharist propels us into humble charity and service.

Easter Vigil, Saturday, April 3 at 8:00p.m. (8:30a.m. Morning Prayer)

If you have not experienced the Easter Vigil, you must! It is the most beautiful Mass of the year. It is our Catholic Church at her best - a glorious evening in which new members are fully initiated.

EASTER SUNDAY, APRIL 4

Masses at 7:00a.m., 8:30a.m., 10:15a.m., 12:00p.m. (No evening Mass)
